Issue Areas

Arts & Cultural Enrichment: The Junior League of Dallas supports efforts to create and enrich the quality of life through arts and cultural enrichment opportunities which are accessible to all members of the community.

Education: The Junior League of Dallas supports efforts to promote excellence in education and access to education for all individuals.

Family Preservation: The Junior League of Dallas supports efforts to promote the physical and emotional well-being of families.

Health: The Junior League of Dallas supports efforts to promote adequate, accessible, and preventive health services to all individuals.

Poverty Intervention: The Junior League of Dallas supports efforts to break the cycle of poverty by meeting the basic needs of the economically disadvantaged.

Violence Intervention: The Junior League of Dallas supports efforts to reduce the incidence of domestic violence, child abuse and juvenile delinquency.





Community Impact

- For the 2021 2022 year (June 1, 2021 May 31, 2022), our nearly 5,000 volunteers will contribute more than 130,000 uncompensated hours to 38 community projects, three signature projects and other projects and committees of the Junior League of Dallas.
- We give approximately \$1 million annually to support nonprofits in the Dallas community
- JLD members serve on more than 50 boards and community coalitions
- Since our inception 100 years ago, JLD members have collaborated to form many of the nonprofits benefiting our community

Community Outreach 2022 - 2023

The Junior League of Dallas operates a **Community** Assistance Fund (CAF) to provide emergency funding for unplanned, short-term needs of nonprofit agencies addressing critical human needs in Dallas County.

Through this fund, agencies can receive immediate **funding of up to \$5,000** to ensure that service to their clients continues without interruption.





Community Outreach 2022 - 2023

The Community Assistance Fund provides emergency funding to agencies that support a **critical human need**:

- Application is available at jld.net > Community
 > Request our support
- Applications are accepted throughout the year

Agencies may receive a maximum of \$5,000 per JLD fiscal year







Provisional Projects

Neda Bahramnejad 2021 – 2022 Chair

- Provisionals are first-year members
- Provisional year includes a one-year comprehensive training course that includes a service component, our Provisional Projects
- Projects train Provisionals to be effective volunteers







- Each project must offer **20 hours of service** opportunities per volunteer (orientation and preparation time count as part of 20 hours)
- Projects are typically completed in a weekend or a few weekends
- Each project must support at least 25 35 volunteers
- Virtual projects (either components or entirely virtual) will be considered





- Each project must make an immediate impact to the agency
- Projects must provide an opportunity to work in a group setting
- Agency must provide a staff member to oversee volunteers for entire project







2021-2022 Provisional Project Examples

- Mission Oak Cliff Back-to-School Bash
- Senior Source Beautification Project
- St. Philip's School and Community Center Christmas Store
- Rainbow Days Feel Good Friday





- JLD provides some funding up to \$700 per project

Transfer Projects 2022 - 2023

Transfer Projects offer members who have transferred into the JLD from other Leagues the opportunity to learn more about Dallas and meet other Transfers.









Transfer Projects 2022 - 2023

- Each project must offer 6-8 hours of service with a 1-hour lunch break included.
- Each project must support at least 25 volunteers and a maximum of 40 volunteers.







Transfer Projects 2022 - 2023

Each project must make an immediate impact to the agency while allowing the members to socially interact.



Application Deadline Monday, April 18th, 2022 5 P.M.







Research & Development Timeline

The R&D process runs April - November 2021.







Required Application Documents

- Grant Application
- Community Impact Report
- Financial Documents:
 - Letter certifying 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status
 - List of current officers and Board of Directors
 - Certificate of insurance
 - Audited financial statements for past 3 years
 - Current annual budget
 - Prior Year actual revenues and expenses compared to prior year budget
 - Most recent internally-prepared financial statements (if applicable)
 - Statement explaining any special/particular financial circumstances the agency wishes to be considered





Community Impact Report

Outcomes Reporting

 Measure outcomes for JLD supported agencies through the Community Impact Report during the application process in order to share the League's impact and specific success stories with JLD members, donors, and the community.

Success Stories

- At **Our Friends Place**, 100 percent of program participants reported improvement in their personal financial management and 92 percent reported an increase in their social and emotional management skills.
- At Genesis Women's Shelter, 80 percent of its adult clients and 60 percent of its child clients who suffer from PTSD report reduced PTSD symptoms by more than 50 percent by the time they leave the shelter.





What We're Looking For

- The majority of our members prefer placements with weekend and/or evening opportunities
 - A quick note on concentrated placements
- Well-defined placements we can share with our members
- Multiple opportunities for members to earn hours





Most Common Reasons for Release

- Difficult for volunteers to earn enough hours
- Unstable financials
- Location for volunteer request is not identified, unclear, or unsafe
- Agency is not a fit with our six issue areas of focus
- Agency fails to fully complete the application, including the Community Impact Report





Other Items of Importance

- Agency requests must be for 10 or more volunteers (not including a Project Chair)
- JLD does not send money to agencies without sending our volunteers
- JLD volunteers are not to be involved in fundraising, medical research, political and/or religious activities
- JLD representative required to hold an ex officio seat on agency's Board
- Agencies must hold an orientation and training session prior to commencement of volunteer





- The deadline for submitting a Community Program application (including Community Impact Report) is Wednesday, April 6, 2022, at 5 p.m.
- To begin the application process, go to <u>www.jld.net</u> and click on Community, then Community Project Requests (R&D).
- Applications must be submitted online; no hard copies accepted.




